Scope and purpose

This release is a patch to the ModusToolbox™ 3.0.0 tools package. This document describes the features and known limitations for the tools included with this patch.

ModusToolbox™ software is a set of tools that enable you to integrate our devices into your existing development methodology. ModusToolbox™ software consists of various libraries and middleware on GitHub, as well as an IDE and tools package installed on your computer. 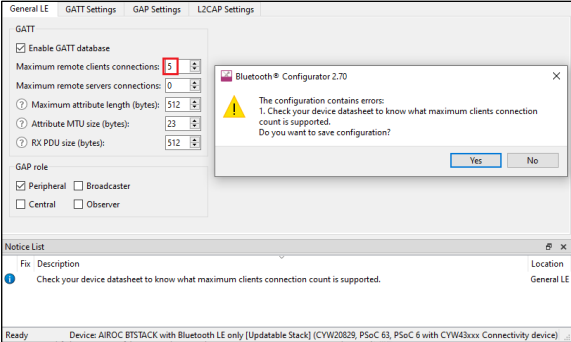

What's included/changed

This patch release provides updated Bluetooth® Configurator version 2.70.0, which uses the AIROC™ BTSTACK middleware library for PSoC™ 63 devices. You may still open and edit old configurations created for the BLESS library, but this feature is deprecated for new configurations starting from this release.

<p>If the configuration contains some information or a warning notice, the user will see the message box stating that an error is present in the configuration when the user tries to save the configuration.</p>  <p>For fields Maximum remote clients connections, Maximum remote servers connections, and TX power, the error message may display for devices CYW20829, PSoC™ 63, PSoC™ 6 with 43xxx Connectivity device.</p> <p>For field TX power, the error message may also display for devices CYW5557x, CYW5551x, and CYW5591x.</p>	<p>The configuration may not contain an error, depending on the target device. Check the device datasheet and if the selected data is correct, proceed with the saving.</p>
<p>The XML configuration files of Bluetooth® Configurator 2.70.0 of ModusToolbox™ 3.0.1 tools package patch are not forward compatible with Bluetooth® Configurator 2.60.0 ModusToolbox™ 3.0.0 tools package.</p>	<p>Open your configuration in the GUI application of Bluetooth® Configurator™ 2.60.0, select the proper device if prompted, save the configuration.</p>

Installation

You must have already installed the ModusToolbox™ 3.0.0™ tools package before installing this patch. If you do not already have the ModusToolbox™ 3.0.0 tools package installed, refer to the ModusToolbox™ installation guide for instructions. After the 3.0.0 version has been installed:

- For Windows and macOS, launch the patch installer and follow the instructions.
- For Linux, extract the ModusToolbox_3.0.1.xxxx-linux-install.tar.gz file into the existing directory where the ModusToolbox™ 3.0.0 tools package was installed.

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
